



LITTLE HALLINGBURY NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN QUESTIONNAIRE RESULTS.

Residents Questionnaires were delivered to 650 homes and businesses in Little Hallingbury between 15th September and 18th September 2023. The deadline for responses was 23rd October 2023.

We received 182 completed Residents Questionnaires which was a marvellous result for the Village. Our thanks to all who took part.

We have also had a number of people volunteer for the LHNP Steering Group, which will now be leading the process to develop the Neighbourhood Plan.

Those that completed the questionnaire have lived in the Village for between 1 and 83 years, the average time being 20 years 5 months.

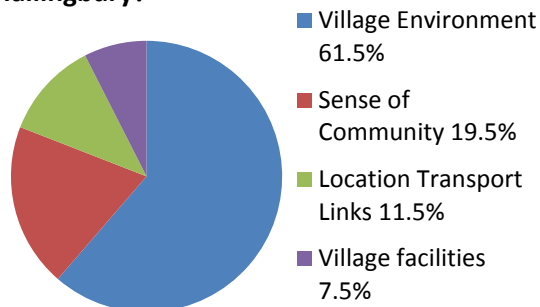
Responses were received from a good spread of ages. Given the differences in life experience between different age groups, as well as the varying views of each generation, it is great to have a spread of opinions across the age range.

In answer to what residents like most about living in Little Hallingbury, It is clear from the feedback that residents love the Village environment, its rural setting and friendliness.



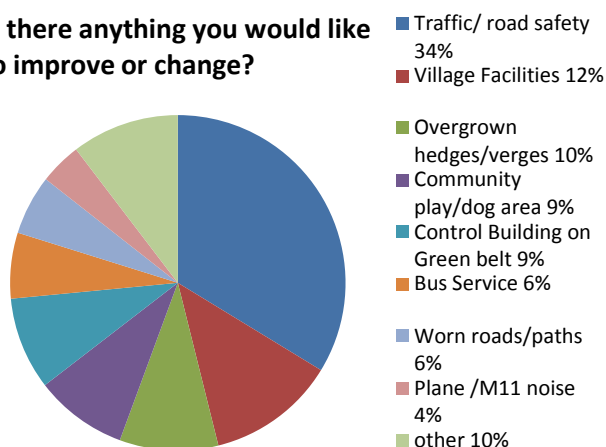
Words used in response to the Little Hallingbury Neighbourhood Plan Residents Questionnaire 2023. Question 4 - What do you like most about living in Little Hallingbury? The words that were used most often in residents' responses are bigger and those used less often are smaller.

When asked what should be improved or changed it was clear that traffic and road safety is the top priority, followed by better Village facilities.

Is there anything you would like to improve or change?



What were given as the top things the Little Hallingbury Neighbourhood Plan should tackle?

The 182 residents who completed the questionnaire mentioned the following areas for the Neighbourhood Plan to tackle.

- Speeding traffic/ Road safety 75% (137)
- Control new development. 49% (89)
- Maintain paths, verges, hedges. 25% (46)
- Preserve Green Belt. 23% (42)
- Airport and M11 Noise. 14% (26)
- Post Office, pub & shop hours/ facilities for community contact. 12.5% (23)
- Other topics. 36% (65)
