The Little Hallingbury Neighbourhood Plan (LHNP) Steering Group is actively working towards finalising the Neighbourhood Plan. In early 2025, the group had a productive meeting with a Planning Consultant appointed by Uttlesford District Council (UDC). The consultant, an expert in Neighbourhood Plan work, provided a thorough appraisal of the draft plan, offering valuable advice on the quality and appropriateness of the evidence gathered so far and identifying any gaps.

Following the consultant's review, the LHNP Steering Group made some revisions and additions to the proposed Neighbourhood Plan policies. These updates were based on the consultant's recommendations and aimed at enhancing the overall quality and effectiveness of the Plan. The updated Vision, Objectives, and Policies were on display at the March 2025 Annual Parish meeting and are available for public viewing on the LHNP website. littlehallingburyneighbourhoodplan.co.uk
