



Neighbourhood Plan Consultation – 21st Nov 25 to 16th Jan 26. Your Chance to Shape Little Hallingbury's Future

The Little Hallingbury Neighbourhood Plan has reached a pivotal moment—and now, it's over to you to shape what comes next. Your voice, as always, is essential.

Following months of community input, expert refinement, and council review, the draft Plan is now entering its formal **Regulation 14 Consultation** phase. This is your final major opportunity to help shape the future of our village before the Plan is submitted for independent examination.

We're inviting all residents to read the draft Plan and share their views. Whether you support it, have suggestions, or want to raise concerns, your feedback will help ensure the Plan reflects our community's values and stands up to scrutiny. **The Consultation is open from 21st Nov until 16th Jan.** All residents will receive details through their door by 21st Nov 2025.

How to Take Part:

- Use a smartphone or computer to visit the Neighbourhood Plan website using the QR code or the URL: www.lhnp.co.uk.
- Access and read the Plan on the link. (From 21st November)
- Access the survey on the link and complete the online response form. (From 21st November)

What Happens Next

After the consultation closes on 16 January 2026, all feedback will be reviewed and responded to. The Plan will then be finalised and submitted to Uttlesford District Council for **independent examination** in spring 2026. Once approved, it will go to a **Parish-wide referendum**. A majority vote in favour will make the Neighbourhood Plan official planning policy.

Your Voice Matters This is a community-led effort, and every comment counts. The Steering Group must and will consider all your feedback which will be used to amend the plan where appropriate to improve it. By taking part now, you're helping to secure a future that recognises the character and priorities of Little Hallingbury.
